Ninety-three percent (93%) of your membership investment is deductible as a business expense. The Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act of 1993 disallows as a business expense that portion of your dues, which are allocable to lobbying at the state or federal level. Dues, contributions, or gifts to the Indiana Council on Animal Welfare are not deductible as charitable contributions for income tax purposes. The Indiana Council on Animal Welfare is a tax exempt entity, but it is classified as a 501(c)6 organization by the IRS. The IRS has ruled that contributions made to 501(c)6 organizations, such as the council, are not eligible as charitable deductions.
